

## GA 505 Columbus Muscogee/ Russell County 2019 Application Appeals Process

If an applicant organization feels it was denied the right to reasonably participate in the local application process or has been unfairly eliminated from the competition, or that a decision made by their local Continuum of Care governing board regarding the ranking, rejection, or funding of their project was prejudicial, or in violation of the 2019 Continuum of Care Guidelines, the applying organization may file an appeal to be re-considered for inclusion in either the local competition or federal competition.

A written appeal request must be submitted to the collaborative applicant, Home for Good/Alliance to End Homelessness within three business days of the notice of the decision to [pat@unitedwayofthecv.org](mailto:pat@unitedwayofthecv.org). The Collaborative Applicant and the CoC Board will hear all appeals. It is the responsibility of the Applicant to address each area (s) identified as a factor(s) of the funding decision in a manner that could result in a more favorable decision. You will be notified of the final decision of your appeal on September 9, 2019 which is more than 15 days of the FY 2019 application deadline of September 30, 2019 as stipulated in the FY 2019 NOFA.
