April is Fair Housing Month. The Georgia Fair Housing Act was created for all Georgians to compete for housing, within their economic means.

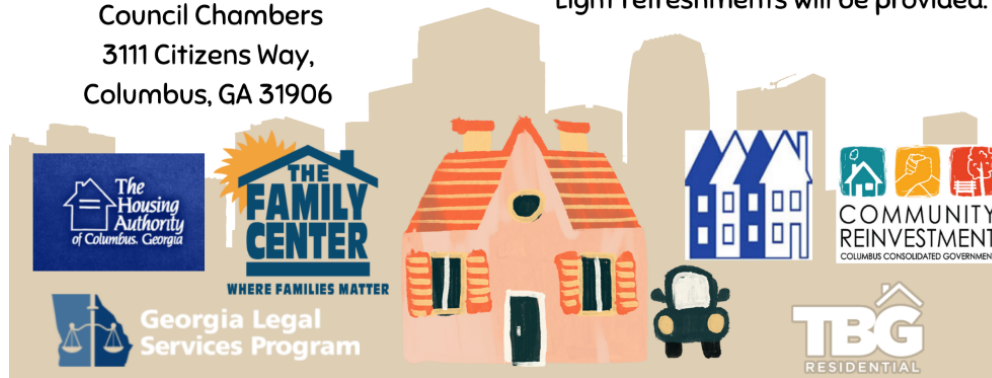
Our event will give tenants access to a panel of speakers who will share about your right to Fair Housing with a question and answer portion at the end. We hope you will join us!
